<b>29 September 2011</b>	The Register was notified that this registrant had criminal convictions for speeding and perverting the course of justice.	Complaint was upheld. The registrant found to be in breach of sections 3.2 and 3.3 of the Code of Conduct and the registrant was expelled from the register, they can reapply after 01 April 2012
<b>04 October 2011</b>	The Register received an allegation that this registrant had failed to attend an interpreting assignment as agreed. Further the registrant had not provided an explanation either to the client or the Register regarding their failure to attend.	Complaint was upheld. The registrant was found to be in breach of sections 3.1,3.2 and 3.4 of the Code of Conduct. The registrant was expelled from the register and cannot re-apply until 04 October 2014
<b>25 October 2011</b>	The Register received a complaint alleging that the registrant had provided a poorly written statement.	Complaint was not upheld
<b>26 October 2011</b>	The Register received a complaint alleging that the registrant had interpreted in a language for which the registrant was not registered.	Complaint was not upheld
<b>02 November 2011</b>	The Register received a complaint that the registrant had made derogatory and sexist comments in an e-mail.	Complaint was not upheld
<b>09 November 2011</b>	The Register was notified that this registrant had criminal convictions for "Destroy or damage Property at a value unknown" and "Having Article with a blade which was Sharply pointed in a Public Place"	Complaint was upheld. The registrant was found to be in breach of sections 3.1,3.2 and 3.3 of the Code of Conduct. The registrant was expelled from the register and cannot re-apply until 15 May 2012
